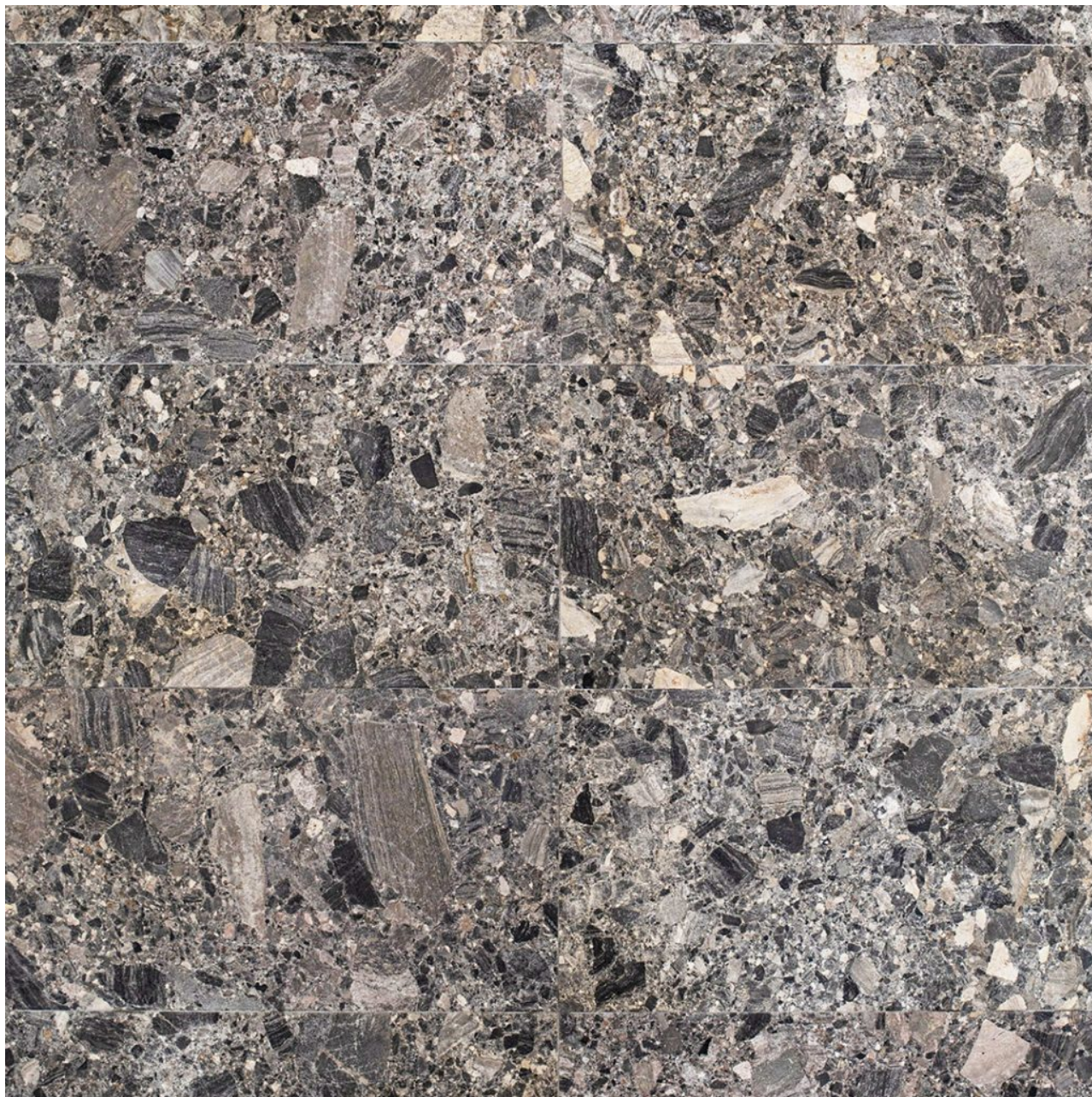


Breccia “Ceppo d’Oriente”



We discovered the quarry for this material while searching for a substitute for the stone used in many buildings in Milan, known as Ceppo di Gré. Given the strong similarity in structure, we named it **Ceppo d’Oriente**, as it is quarried abroad.

The intense gray color and marble aggregates make it a modern material with a retro touch.

This material also resembles a stone used in Tuscany in Siena for the masonry of historic Towers and Palaces.

It is a cavernous limestone called “**Pietra da Torre**” which then fell out of use and was replaced by travertine.
